2015 Elite All Star Showcase Skills competition information and rules *** PLAYERS MUST SIGN UP FOR SKILLS COMPETITION AT PLAYER CHECK IN. ONE COMPETITION PER PLAYER ONLY. SKILLS COMPETITION IS OPTIONAL. IF PLAYERS IS NOT AT FIELD WHEN NAME CALLED THEN THEY ARE ELIMINATED FOR THE COMPETITION. ***

Each contest will crown a 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , and 3^{rd} place winner for each age group. Awards will be presented at the white tent area, immediately after the last player competes

Home Run contest:

8u: Fences will be set at approx. 120-125 ft.

First round: Players need to hit 2 home runs out of 12 hits or strikes. Players will hit off the machine. After a player hits 2 home runs in round 1 then they advance to round 2. If they do not hit 2 home runs in round 1 then they are eliminated.

Second round: The player who hits the most home runs out of 10 swings or strikes wins. (Round one total does not count towards winner. Round 1 is only an advancement round.

In the event of a tie in round 2, players will each have 3 swings/strikes. Player with most home runs wins. If tied after 3 swings, then players enter 1 swing sudden death rounds to determine a champion.

Accuracy contest: Players will be given time to warm up.

8u: Distance will be approx. 110-120 ft

Points awarded as follows: If balls enters the sock net hole on the fly = 5 pts. If ball enters sock net hole on a bounce(s) = 3 pts. If ball hits sock net on either the fly or a bounce = 1 pt.

6 throws for each player = Players with most points win. In case of a tie = Each player gets 3 more throws.

Speed Competition:

All players will be timed by two stopwatches from home to first, and from home to home. The two stopwatches will be averaged, and the overall added times of both runs will determine the winners. The top three scores will receive 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} place finishes in each age group. Bases set at 60 ft
